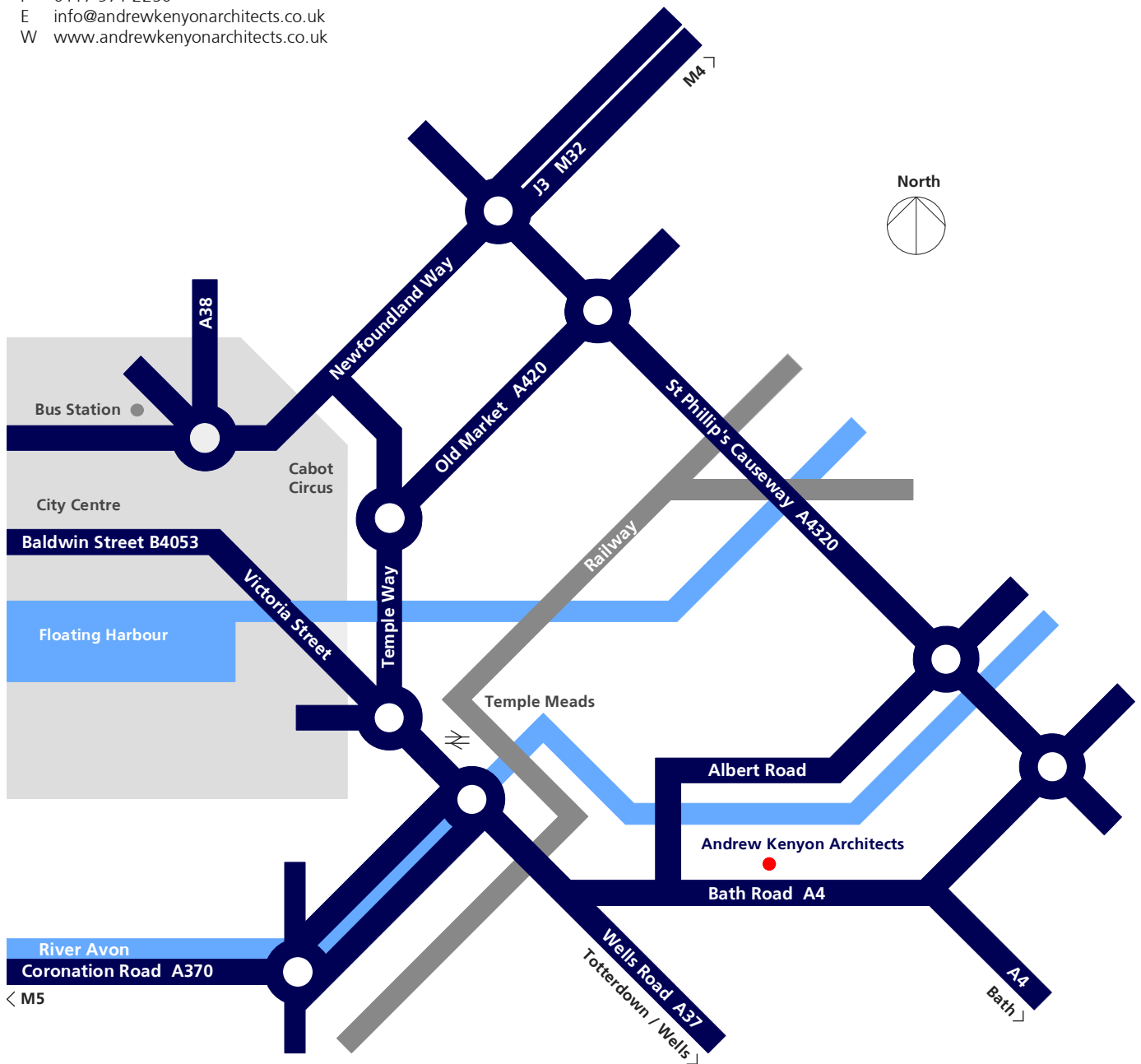

Paintworks is a 5 hectare regeneration development on the site of a former Victorian paint factory, adjacent to the River Avon. It is situated to the South East of Bristol city centre, near Totterdown. It is easily accessible via train, car, bike or foot; with free parking on site.

From the M32: leave at junction 3, following signs for Bath. Turn right at the Sainsbury's roundabout - and right again at the next traffic lights, following the sign for Totterdown & Temple Meads. You are on the A4 Bath Road. Paintworks is on the right hand side just beyond Arnos Vale Cemetery and Majestic Wine.

From Bristol city centre and/or Temple Meads Station: head towards Bath along the A4 Bath Road. Bare left at the 3 Lamps traffic lights and straight on at the next traffic lights. 250m further - Paintworks is on the left hand side. There is a large red light box on the roof at the entrance.

On entering the site, pass the Bocabar on the left and turn left downhill. 5.8 is on the right.
